Adoption Policy

At Plymouth Veterinary Clinic, our mission is to build better lives for pets and the people who love them. On occasion, we here at Plymouth Veterinary Clinic will take in a patient who was found as an injured stray or a surrender. Our goal is to provide necessary medical care for these patients and place them in a home where they will continue to receive necessary treatment and preventative care tailored to their personal needs.

- All applicants must be 18 years or older.
- Applicants must agree to have the pet spayed/neutered, provide final vaccines, and veterinary care. (if needed)
- Any applicant renting must have written permission from the landlord.
- All adults in the home must be aware of the responsibilities of pet ownership before adopting.
- All applicants must adhere to all laws and ordinances.
- We **do not** permit the adoption of animals as gifts for someone else.
- We **do not** adopt out our dogs for the sole purpose of security.

We encourage a meet-and-greet and/or a trial period to make sure you and the animal are a good fit for each other. If, for any reason, the animal does not work out in its new environment, we ask that you contact the clinic for help in rehoming it. We highly encourage considering any small children in the home and understanding the responsibility to ensure proper training, education, and safety for both the pet and children.
